We want everyone to have an enjoyable day! To help us to achieve this, please abide by the rules, obey safety officers and stewards, and listen to announcements.

Midleton Agricultural Show Society, Rules and Regulations.

1. Intending exhibitors are requested to peruse the rules and regulations and be prepared to comply with them.
2. Exhibits of the Indoor Section will be judged on Saturday (day before the show). Exhibitors please note - all entries in these classes must be in place by 3:30pm on Saturday and cannot be removed before 4:30pm on Sunday.
3. No entries will be accepted after the stipulated closing date.
4. A person entering an Exhibit and failing to send same for exhibition shall forfeit the entry fee.
5. Intending exhibitors are requested to peruse the rules and regulations and be prepared to comply with them.
6. The Society reserves the right to alter or cancel any class or competition at any time.
7. The Society takes no responsibility for accidents.
8. Objections to any winner in any class or competition must be Lodged in writing with €50, which is forfeited if objection is not upheld, to the secretary within 1 Hour of event /competition.
9. Exhibitors are to understand that although every reasonable precaution will be taken to ensure the safety and welfare of animals The society will not be responsible for loss or damage or accident of any kind that may occur neither will the society be accountable for any accident that may occur to any person attending the show whether as a visitor exhibitor, or otherwise.
10. The Committee reserve the right to refuse entries, varying, the prize list, or arrangements, or removing any animal or other exhibit at any time during the show. The Society shall not in any way be liable for any claim for compensation or otherwise arising out of the holding, abandonment or postponement of the show, nor for any claim arising out of or connected with the show.
11. Exhibitors accept that the Judges' decision is FINAL in all cases. ANY abuse/harassment of Judges/Stewards/Officials will not be tolerated.
12. Exhibitors/Competitors must obey the stewards at all times.
13. Protective head gear conforming to recommended kitemark standard and fitted with an adjustable harness. It is compulsory for all riders under 16yrs and for riders in the working hunter horse and working hunter pony competitions and ridden show classes.
14. Anyone found interfering with any exhibit or disarranging any display will be asked to leave the grounds, For conveniences of exhibitors the society has arranged a veterinary surgeon will be on call at short notice to attend to sick or injured animals, but fees for this service will be payable by the owner concerned.
15. Exhibitors of animals are requested to have their own Insurance Cover & Public Liability.
16. The Irish Shows Association Levy of 5% will be deducted from all prize money in the relevant sections: horses, ponies, donkeys, cattle, sheep.
17. Winners of qualifiers are themselves responsible for entering their animals (or exhibits) for the FINAL. On completion of judging, they must attend the Show Secretary's Office within ONE HOUR, and complete the necessary documentation and pay entry fee for the FINAL.
18. The Society will not be responsible for any errors in either Entry Forms, Schedule,

or Show Book.

19. Cars are parked at owners' risk.
20. Any handler whose animal is not under his/her control may be asked to remove said animal from the arena or show field at the discretion of the Safety Officers, Judge or Stewards.
21. Trade Stand Owners must have their own Public Liability Insurance Certificate.
22. All Exhibitors must display their numbers so that they can be easily seen and read.
23. Safety Officers must be obeyed at all times.
24. Only competent persons are allowed to exhibit animals.
25. All cattle entries must comply with Department of Agriculture regulations.
26. One person only will be admitted free with each livestock exhibit, but two persons may be admitted with a bull.
27. The society requires the winners of cups and trophies, to sign for receipt of same and give an undertaking to return same in as good a condition as it was received at least 28 days before the next show.
28. Withdrawal of entries are not refundable.
29. ALL EXHIBITORS are advised to have their Public Liability Insurance up to date.

N.B. ABSOLUTELY NO LATE ENTRIES CAN BE ACCEPTED - PLEASE ENTER ON TIME

Important notice to all owners /exhibitors involved in the showing of animals.

The Irish Shows Association would advise all Animal owners who have their Animals Insured to have their Insurance cover extended to cover them while showing Animals at Shows we understand that it costs very little or nothing at all depending on who you have Insurance cover with. The reason for us in giving you this advice is that if your animal were to lash out and injure someone or damage someone's property and it is established that your animal was out of control at the time you may be held responsible or partly responsible for any injury or damage caused and could end up paying all or part of any settlement reached.

6 Small Hunter - Killusty Show Qualifier

Description: Killusty Show – Small Hunter Championship Final
Rules for Small Hunter Championship 2026

1. Qualifying rounds will be held at designated shows.
2. The qualifying horse may be a MARE or GELDING, 4 years old and over. The horse must be over 148cms but not exceeding 158cms.
3. The Small Hunter should be a blood horse. He/She should be short of leg, with a good deep body and should have a lot of character and presence with an exemplary temperament.
4. First and Second placed small hunters in designated shows may qualify for the final. In the event of 1 st and 2 nd being qualified, 3 rd and 4 th may go forward to the final.
5. Judge of the day must sign the qualifying entry form(s)
6. On completion of judging at qualifiers the successful qualifier will be given all relevant entry documentation by the ring steward. This must be completed and returned, along with the appropriate fee, to the secretary of Killusty Show within 14 days - this rule will be strictly adhered to. Online entry will be available on itsplainsailing.com when entries open.
7. The rider must be 16 years and over on 01/01/2026.
8. Tack and Turn Out Recommended for Ridden Hunter Classes: Mane should be plaited, tail pulled. Heels trimmed. Plain tack, brown is preferred. Black tack is very rarely seen in affiliated Hunter classes. Double or pelham for open classes, snaffles for novices. If a rugby pelham is used, then a sliphead improves the look a lot. Plain browband and noseband. A straight cut or working hunter saddle will show off the horse's shoulders and movement. Leather girth, or a white one is acceptable if your horse is grey, as a dark girth can distract the eye. Quartermarkers are correct (optional) for hunters and hunter ponies.
9. Rider Attire: Beige or canary jodhpurs or breeches, long boots. Shirt and tie. Tweed jacket. Spurs may be worn, but dummy spurs are acceptable.
10. Horses will be judged on type, conformation, way of going, ridden performance and action in-hand.
11. Random Dope testing may be carried out on the day of the final.
12. Horse passports must be present on the day of the final.
13. Any objection must be lodged in writing with the show secretary within half an hour following the completion of the competition, together with €50 which is refundable if the objection is upheld.
14. Killusty Show Committee, in consultation with the sponsor, reserves the right to amend the rules as may be deemed necessary.

13 Novice Race Horse to Riding Horse

Description: NOVICE RACEHORSE TO RIDING HORSE CLASS

- For horses 4 years older, mares and gelding, any height. Riders minimum age 16yo.
 - A novice is a horse in its first two years of affiliated competition* and has not won a Racehorse to Riding Horse class prior to this season's competition.
 - Horses to be ridden in a snaffle bridle only, with a plain cavesson noseband.
 - Novice horses will not be required to gallop. The judge will not ride Novice horses, but will request a short individual show, as defined by the judge(s).
- * (not above Dressage Ireland preliminary, Eventing Ireland EI90, Showjumping Ireland 90cms, AIRC intermediate, IPC intermediate)

The first and second prize winners in the Novice and the Open classes at each qualifier, will qualify for the final. In the case where the first and/or second placed horse has already qualified, the next placed horse may qualify for the final at the judges discretion. Combinations may only compete in one section (either Novice or Open) at the final of the Tattersalls Ireland Treo Eile Showing Pathway Series. A Novice combination that has qualified for the final, and also qualifies in an Open qualifier throughout the series, must compete in the Open section of the Showing Pathway Series' final. A rider/horse combination that qualifies in the Novice class and subsequently is placed (1st-6th) in the Racehorse to Riding Horse class at the Dublin Horse Show, may not return to compete in the Novice Final. This progression will be rewarded with a 'wild card' place in the Open Final. The final is restricted to the exact rider/horse combination that qualified, with no substitutions permitted

14 Open Race Horse to Riding Horse

Description: OPEN RACEHORSE TO RIDING HORSE CLASS

- For horses 4 years older, mares and gelding, any height. Riders minimum age 16yo.
- Horses that have won a Racehorse to Riding Horse class and/or competed in the Racehorse to Riding Horse class at the Dublin Horse Show in previous seasons, must compete in the Open class.
- Horses to be ridden in a snaffle, pelham or simple double bridle with a plain cavesson noseband. Riders will be asked to extend the canter with the class. Horses to be ridden by the judge.

The first and second prize winners in the Novice and the Open classes at each qualifier, will qualify for the final. In the case where the first and/or second placed horse has already qualified, the next placed horse may qualify for the final at the judges discretion. Combinations may only compete in one section (either Novice or Open) at the final of the Tattersalls Ireland Treo Eile Showing Pathway Series. A Novice combination that has qualified for the final, and also qualifies in an Open qualifier throughout the series, must compete in the Open section of the Showing Pathway Series' final. A rider/horse combination that qualifies in the Novice class and subsequently is placed (1st-6th) in the Racehorse to Riding Horse class at the Dublin Horse Show, may not return to compete in the Novice Final. 2. The Champion Supreme Pony from designated shows may qualify for the final. In the event of the Champion already being qualified, the Reserve receives the qualifier. If both the Champion and the Reserve are already qualified then the qualifier will be reallocated to another show later in the showing calendar.
3. The Pony Supreme qualifying classes include; In-hand Pony Champion (Welsh/ Broodmare), Youngstock Pony Champion, Connemara In-hand Champion, Connemara Ridden Champion, Connemara Working Hunter Champion, Show Pony Champion, Show Hunter Pony Champion, Open & Novice Working Hunter Pony Champion, Starter Stakes Champion, Intermediate Pony Champion, Mini Champion.
4. As the Intermediate Pony is included in the qualifiers; all pony entries must not exceed 158cms.
5. In the interest of fairness to all exhibitors, where qualifying shows hold separate Mini Supreme champ; Supreme Championship, there must be an overall Supreme chosen from these two champions. To decide the overall champion, they must compete against one another and be judged accordingly. It should be considered as a separate class and must comprise of a show piece. Please brief judges on the qualifying rules in advance of judging the Supreme.
6. Under IPS Rules, ponies must be measured before competing in ANY Ridden Class. The pony owner or the person responsible for presenting the pony at the Measuring Session is responsible for making themselves familiar with the Rules of Measuring ponies and those of Appeal. Ponies owned, wholly or partially, by Irish residents of the thirty-two (32) counties (irrespective of where such ponies are located or maintained) must compete under IPS or SJI Measurement Schemes to comply with the Rules therein. The Council, through its relevant committee,

authority to ask for any pony to be re-measured.

7. Finalists (pony and rider combination) must compete in a minimum of one class at Killusty Show on the 4/7/26.

8. On arrival in the final on the day of the show, the finalists will receive €50 for participating in the final. In the event of a finalist not presenting at the final, their €50 will be added to the Champion's prize money. The Champion of the All Ireland Pony Champion Supreme final receives €500.

9. Riders must have attained their 4th Birthday by the 1/1/2026.

10. On completion of judging at qualifiers the successful qualifier will be given all relevant entry documentation by the ring steward. This must be completed and returned, along with the appropriate fee, to the secretary of Killusty Show within 14 days - this rule will be strictly adhered to.

11. Ponies will be judged on type, conformation, way of going and action in-hand.

12. Random Dope testing may be carried out on the day of the final.

13. Any objection must be lodged in writing with the show secretary within half an hour following the completion of the competition, together with €50 which is refundable if the objection is upheld.

14. This Championship is open to IPS members and Non - IPS members.

15. Finalist may be asked perform a set show for the final.

16. In the event that a qualified finalist cannot attend the final, we ask that you inform the secretary out of courtesy as soon as possible. A 'wild card' may be provided to a show that did not receive a qualifier in the draw for the shows to ensure that the final has maximum participants.

17. Killusty Show Committee, in consultation with the sponsor, reserves the right to amend the rules as may be deemed necessary.
